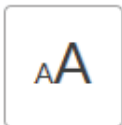


# You can save money on prescriptions and donate to the Regional Food Bank, for free

OKLAHOMA CITY (KOKH) — A free prescription card, can save you at the pharmacy and help feed people in Oklahoma.



Watertree Health is partnering with the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma. [You can print out a card, get one mailed to you, or get a digital copy, for free.](#) The card is accepted, in conjunction with insurance or on it's own, at thousands of pharmacies including places like Homeland, CVS, and Walmart.



Watertree says, on average, people save \$364 a year on prescriptions with the card.

Everytime you used it, Watertree donates money to the Food Bank. Donations have already paid for more than 400,000 meals, the Regional Food Bank said.

The food bank, knows how important this issue is.

Every week, the food bank helps feed more than 100,000 people in Oklahoma. Officials there say 66% of clients have admitted, they've had to choose between paying for medical care at some point. They say, inconsistent access to health food is linked to obesity, diabetes, hypertension and heart issues.
